Meet information and Promoters Conditions

General Conditions apply, as published in the Regional handbooks and on the websites.

1. Entries shall be submitted electronically via the competitor's club coordinator. All entry files, summary sheets and payment shall arrive with the event administrator at the address below by the closing date, **Tuesday 6th April 2010.**

2. Electronic entry is mandatory for all clubs and the following applies:
 - a. Any manual entry is subject to a £2.50 administration fee.
 - b. After the closing date refunds for entry fees will only be given on medical grounds, if an appropriate medical certificate is provided.
3. The club coordinator shall be responsible for:
 - a. Checking and validating the entries and fees
 - b. Entering the information into the Entry Manager Computer program.
 - c. Returning the entry file by email to the event administrator.
4. **For entries returned electronically then there is no requirement to submit paper entry forms, but you must send a completed summary form and payment.** Notification of accepted entries shall be via a processed entries list on the website. Should rejections occur then these will be notified by email to the club coordinator.
5. The club coordinator is responsible for checking the processed entries and reporting any errors, discrepancies and known withdrawals to the event administrator. Known errors and withdrawals must be notified before the day of meet.
6. Withdrawals prior to the day of meet, Email meets@asaem.org.uk
7. Withdrawal on the day of meet
 - a. Final notice of the withdrawal of any swimmers from a club shall be reported to the recorder, one hour prior to the start of the session. Withdrawals must be reported using the official forms provided. For last minute problems send a text message to **07923 430711**
 - b. Once the event has been seeded, subsequent withdrawals will only be allowed on medical grounds.

- c. Notice of withdrawal from a final, **including reserves**, shall be given to the Meet Manager within **1 hour of the publication of the list of finalists, but no later than 30mins after the end of session**. Withdrawals after these deadlines may only be made on medical grounds.
 - d. Failure to comply with these conditions shall result in a fine of £10 for a heat and £20 for a final which must be paid before the swimmer competes again in the Championships. In the event of a swimmer not paying the fine, the club in whose name the swimmer has entered the competition shall be responsible for payment.
7. A swimmer failing to comply with any of the foregoing conditions shall not be allowed to compete in the championship concerned.
8. Should a final comprise of only one swimmer then an award will be made only if the swimmer achieves or improves on the qualifying time for that particular event.
9. The planned start time of each day is 9.00am, however confirmed start times for all sessions will be advised when entries have closed.
